Providing support, mentorship, and fostering professional development for emerging governance leaders and board directors.



Offering hands-on learning opportunities through observing and participating in effective governance practices.



Facilitating exposure to culturally empowering networks, with the guidance of your assigned mentor, and access to valuable networking opportunities.



Enhancing education and professional development through training and workshop content.

Mentorship:

 6 sessions with an experienced mentor, including pre- and postmeeting preparation and a career conversation.

Observership:

 Attend at least 2 board meetings to learn governance practices firsthand.

Workshops & Training:

- 2 in-person, two-day workshops (July 16-17th & April 15-16th).
- 7 online training sessions.

Networking:

• Engage with peers, mentors, and external partners.

As the program continues we're hoping to increase the number of participants to ensure everyone who can benefit from this program has access to it.




